Prof Har Gobind Khorana was an Indian-American Biochemist who made ground breaking contributions to the chemical synthesis of genetic material. He was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology and Medicine in 1968 along with Marshall Nirenberg and Robert Holley for the interpretation of genetic code and its function. He was bestowed with Padma Vibhushan in 1969 by Govt of India.
